

## FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

### *What is WSCA?*

*Sprint has an agreement with the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) contract #S1523, offering both iDEN and CDMA products and services, CNS, ERT\* and Data link. WSCA is a pre-competed contract so members can easily procure services without going out for bid and negotiating separate contracts.*

*WSCA is Sprint's largest State and Local public sector wireless contract. WSCA operates in 26 states across the nation and in countless local agencies.*

### *Who qualifies to use WSCA?*

*All CL purchases under the WSCA contract must be for government use only defined as: state agencies, cities, counties, courts, public healthcare, public utilities, public schools, public institutions of higher education. Individual states may include non-profits and corroborative agencies – please check with your local PSAM on your state specifics.*

### *How can I set up my customer to use WSCA?*

*Agreement takes effect when participating states or government entities sign a PA (participating addendum) to the master WSCA contract.
